## APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS

### To be included with application:

- Provide at least ONE letter of recommendation for the child from a non-family member (i.e. coach, instructor, teacher, counselor, caseworker).
- Copy of letter from the child's school indicating child qualifies for free or reduced lunch at school. Or you can provide proof of all family income. If initial application is approved, parent/guardian will need to provide the following at a meeting with a Day Dreams Foundation representative:
- Copy of birth certificate or any form listing the child's date of birth to verify age.

### Other requirements after scholarship is awarded:

- Day Dreams Kids are asked to participate in activities to help their community. Opportunities will be made available through the Day Dreams Foundation or the child can choose their own projects.

## ACTIVITIES

- Qualify for free or reduced lunch at school
- Submit application TWO WEEKS in advance
